

MEETING MINUTES

Paul Selby the Treasurer's read the monthly Treasurer's report and made note of the fact that in September there was a outstanding amount owed \$2700 to the HOA in assessments but now that balance was only \$142.00

Joann introduced Stacey Doll and the Springfield Neighborhood Watch. Currently Levi Landing is part of the Thurston Flats area, but the Watch is hopeful that a block captain/coordinator might be interested in helping establish a sub-group since Levi Landing is a unique area. Recently, Thurston has added 5 new areas. They work closely with the Springfield Police Department and work towards the goal of connecting neighbors and building communities to support and care for each other.

The "Lock Out Crime" program and an engraving machine (for labeling electronics) is available at the PD. These are benefits that the citizens can use. Neighborhood watch groups have been proven to reduce crime.

The Nextdoor App has also proven useful to keep people informed of what's going on in the neighborhood.
